

CONSTITUTION OF THE
ALAMO AREA ATHLETIC TRAINERS ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the organization shall be the Alamo Area Athletic Trainers Association.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

1. To promote educational and charitable opportunity for all Student Trainers.
2. To promote the highest possible standards for Athletic Trainers and the free exchange of ideas within the association to further the ability of its members.
3. To promote the advancement of the athletic training profession in all its phases, and to promote a better working relationship among those persons interested in the care and prevention of athletic injuries, and in the education and well being of all athletes.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

Anyone interested in the advancement of Athletic Training may become a member.

ARTICLE IV – DUES

Dues will be twenty dollars (\$20.00) a year, which will include the annual clinic. Students will be charged no fees or dues.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

1. There shall be a President, Vice-President, Second Vice-President, a permanent Secretary, and a permanent Treasurer. These five members along with the Past President will compose the Executive Board.
2. The Vice-President and the Second Vice-President will advance to the next highest office each year, with only the election of a Second Vice-President. Should a vacancy other than advancement occur, the office shall be filled by a vote of the membership at the annual meetings. In the event the Secretary or the Treasurer must be replaced between meetings then the President shall appoint a replacement until the next

annual meeting. In the event the President withdraws between annual meetings, then the next officer in line shall be the chief executive officer until the next annual meeting.

3. The election of officers shall occur by a majority vote of the membership present at the annual business meeting.
4. All officers assume their duties immediately.
5. All nominations of officers will come from the floor of the annual business meeting.

ARTICLE VI – VOTING

1. Only “Licensed and/or Certified Members” of the Alamo Area Athletic Trainers Association can vote.
2. All voting will be done conducted on a written ballot.

ARTICLE VII – MEETING

The site and time of the annual clinic shall be voted on at the annual business meeting of the Alamo Area Athletic Trainer Association.

ARTICLE VIII – COMMITTEES

The Executive Board shall appoint all committee members, as they deem necessary.

ARTICLE IX – DISSOLUTION OF ASSOCIATION

Upon the dissolution of Alamo Area Athletic Trainers Association, the Executive Committee, after paying any present bills, will dispose of all assets to a tax-exempt organization. If not, all assets will be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas in Bexar County to a tax-exempt organization.

ARTICLE X – AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION

The constitution shall become valid and binding upon approval of the majority of the voting members in attendance at the February 18, 1984 business meeting and can be amended by a two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) vote at the annual meeting.
